You **must have known the referee for a minimum of one year** (two years or more is strongly recommended).

The referee must fill out the Candidate Evaluation Form by evaluating and commenting on at least 8 of the following 12 areas: Integrity, Interpersonal Relations, Knowledge of Profession, Leadership, Oral Communication, Organizational Skills, Reaction to Criticism, Self-Awareness, Stress Management, Team Skills, Time Management, and Written Communication.

All reference letters must be signed and dated. Candidate Evaluations Forms must be sent to Boucher Admissions directly from the referee, either by mail, fax or email.
