All members of the Boucher community, including students, student clubs and groups, administrators and faculty may not solicit funds, conduct prize draws, and sell food or any other item involving a monetary transaction for any purpose, including fundraising, on the Boucher campus without permission. Members of the Boucher community may not advertise or promote any products or events without permission. Third parties and vendors are not permitted to advertise, promote or sell products on the Boucher campus unless approved by the President and must enter a vendor or sponsorship agreement with the Boucher Institute should approval be granted. 50/50 draws, all other gambling activities and the sale of alcohol and drugs are strictly prohibited. Students, staff, and faculty may obtain permission to raise funds or sell products or services by submitting an application form. Any person(s) that violates this policy is subject to disciplinary action.
